## **Procedure and Conditions for Appointing Arbitrators**

### **Education and professional qualifications of the Arbitrator**

The Arbitrator must have university education in the field of the law or information technologies.

### **Arbitrator's field of specialisation**

The Arbitrator must have professional orientation or specialisation in the field of Internet domains, intellectual property rights, information technologies, computer law, media and communications law or protection of competition.

### **Languages**

The Arbitrator should speak Serbian and English.

### **Work experience**

The Arbitrator must have work experience in the field of the law, information technologies, intellectual property, Internet domains, as well as experience as a judge or a lawyer, or experience of being engaged in arbitration.

### **Membership in professional organisations**

It is desirable that the Arbitrator is a member of relevant expert and scientific international or national associations from the field of the law and information technologies.

### **Procedure of electing arbitrators**

The Managing Board of RNIDS publishes an open competition for arbitrators. Candidates for arbitrators submit the application to RNIDS in writing, along with CV and a copy of their university diploma.

After the termination of the procedure of electing arbitrators, RNIDS will inform all candidates about their decision and invite the selected arbitrators to sign the statement on accepting the duty.
